The Chancellor's Scholar Award recognizes students* who graduate as Valedictorian (ranked #1) or Salutatorian (ranked #2) of their high school class.

The award covers 100% of tuition & fees charges (after other tuition-specific assistance is applied), plus 50% of the rent of living in Purdue University Calumet's student housing facility, The University Village, for fall and spring semesters. Additionally, each Chancellor's Scholar Award recipient receives a monetary allowance toward the purchase of books and supplies.

Recipients must maintain full-time student status during each of the fall and spring semesters and a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 (4.0 scale) to continue to qualify for the renewable, annual award. The award is limited to eight (8) semesters of continuous attendance. Award qualifiers must attend Purdue University Calumet within one year after graduating from high school.

**Applicants must be enrolled at a secondary institution that offers competitive class ranking.*
