Eligibility Criteria

1. Must be a first time student at Purdue University Calumet.
2. Must be approved for the Enrollment Incentive Award before registering for courses at Purdue University Calumet. The Office of Admissions processes this approval.
3. Must be able to transfer a minimum of sixty (60) credits to Purdue University Calumet.
4. Must have a cumulative GPA of B (3.0) average in prior college course work.

Award Guidelines

1. The Award applies only to tuition for 300 and 400 level courses in your baccalaureate degree

program.

2. The Award recipient must take at least nine (9) credits at the 300 and/or 400 levels per semester for the award to post to their tuition.
3. The Award applies to the Fall and Spring Semesters only.
4. The Award recipient must be continuously enrolled in the Fall and Spring Semesters with no break in enrollment for the duration of the program. Non-enrollment in the Summer Semester does not constitute a break in enrollment.
5. The Enrollment Incentive Award may not be used in conjunction with the Best and Brightest Transfer Scholarship.
6. The Award recipient must maintain a non-Indiana domicile.

Award Amount

The Enrollment Incentive Award covers the difference between the out-of-state tuition and the tuition for Indiana residents. The value to you of this program exceeds \$1,700.00 per semester with nine (9) credits at the 300/400 level.

Continued Eligibility Criteria

1. Must maintain a cumulative GPA of B (3.0) at Purdue University Calumet.
2. Must be continuously enrolled in the Fall and Spring Semester.

Award Period

The award is available for a total of four (4) semesters of enrollment within a six (6) semester timeframe, starting with the first semester your award is scheduled to begin.

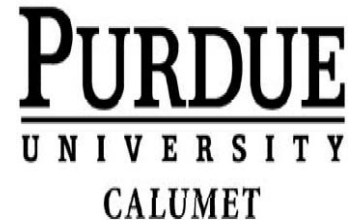
