

Transfer Program in Pre-Forestry Major

As a current college student, you may be considering transferring to Purdue WL to complete your degree. Transfer applications are reviewed on an individual and holistic basis. Such review encompasses much of the same criteria that apply to beginning college students, such as:

- [High school subject matter expectations](#)
- Overall grades in academic coursework
- Grades related to intended major
- Ability to be successful in intended major
- Personal background and experiences
- Time of year the student applies
- Space availability in the intended program

In addition to the above criteria, transfer applicants must achieve the appropriate college grade point average (GPA). If you did not meet the subject-matter requirements while in high school, WL will review your college transcript(s) to determine if you have made up those deficiencies.

Admission Criteria for Transfer Students depends on the Purdue School you wish to enter. Based on space availability, the GPA requirements could be raised or the program could be closed without published notice.
