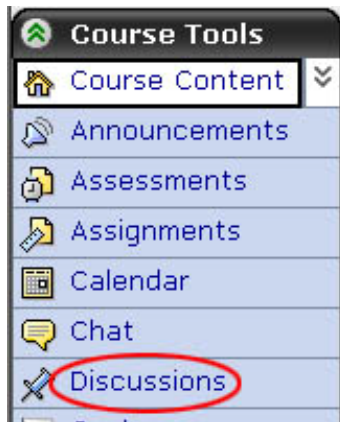


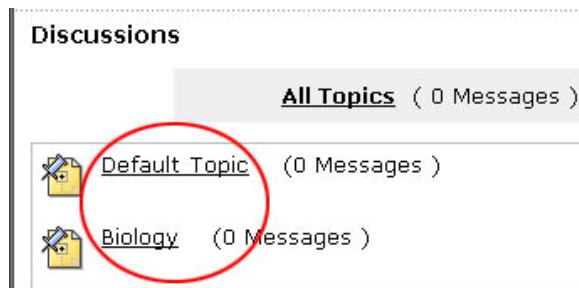

Posting a Discussion

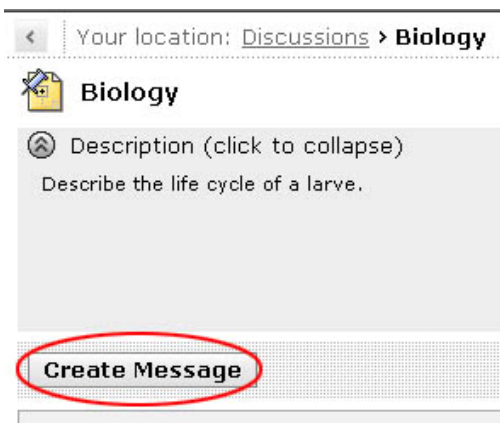
After logging into **Blackboard Vista 4.0** and selecting your **course**, *click* the **Discussions** button located under **Course Tools**.
