

2009-2010 Verification Worksheet

Your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for a "Verification" process which compares information from your FAFSA with signed copies of your (and your spouse's, if you are married) 2008 Federal tax forms, W-2 forms, and/or other financial documents. Based on this review Purdue University Calumet may need to make electronic corrections to your FAFSA information. Verification must be completed by Sept. 27, 2010 or 120 days after your last day of enrollment for 2009/2010. Verification includes receipt of a valid correct Institutional Student Information Record (ISIR) with an official Expected Family Contribution (EFC). Failure to complete the verification process by the deadline will result in financial aid not being disbursed.

What you should do

1. Complete and sign this Verification Worksheet.
2. Submit the completed Verification Worksheet, signed copies of your (and your spouse's) Federal tax forms, W-2 form(s), and any other requested documents to the Office of Financial Aid and Student Accounts **as soon as possible so that determination of your financial aid eligibility will not be delayed.**

Purdue University Calumet must review the requested information under the financial program rules 34CFR, Part 668.
