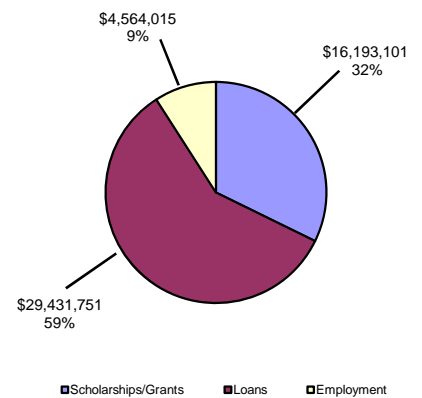

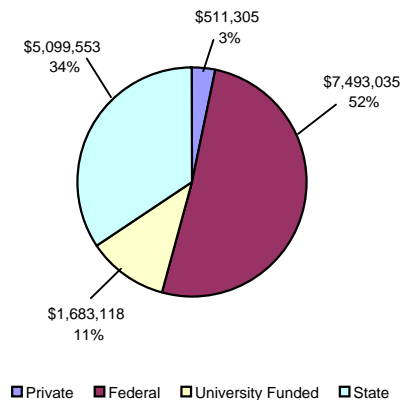

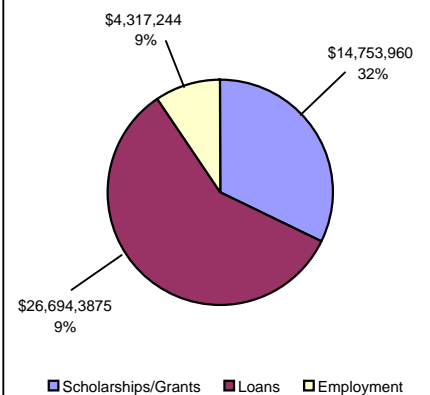

UNDERGRADUATE COST OF ATTENDANCE 2005-06 ACADEMIC YEAR



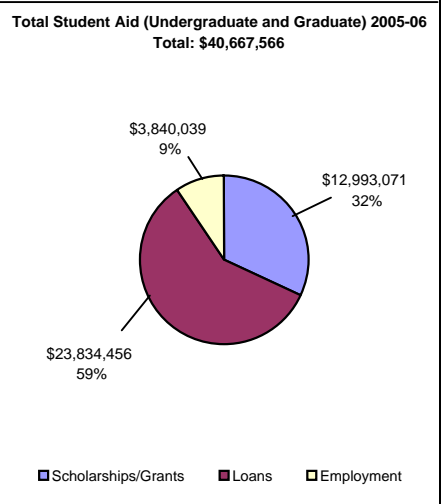

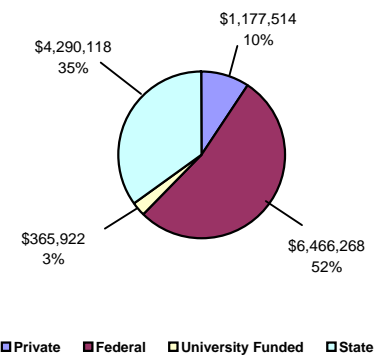

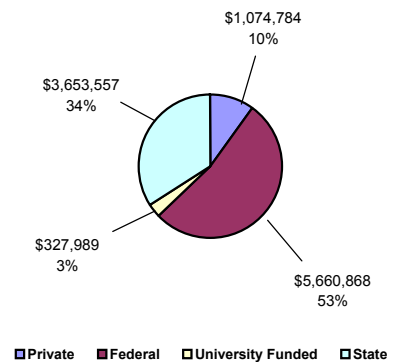
UNDERGRADUATE COST OF ATTENDANCE 2003-04 ACADEMIC YEAR
